Incorporating the re-use of a local century old square-log building as the crux of its design, this residence brings a storied Bozeman ranch to bold new life. The project reconciled the clients' requests for a modern, casual, and comfortable living atmosphere while retaining the unique character of handcrafted timber homes of old. Taking full advantage of a spectacular sloped site, this prominent home emerges from the bold landscape, exuding the strength and character of architecture crafted from the land. Extensive use of native stone brings the home comfortably into permanent union with its site, while vast expanses of glass extend the sweeping, dramatic landscape into the home.

Integrating the owners demanding programmatic requirements while retaining architectural integrity is the true hallmark of this project. Soaring interior spaces are brought into comfortable human scale with rich native materials, exposed structural timbers and immaculate detailing inspired by historical precedent. From this home's programming to the last finish, this project represents a consummate effort to achieve balance and refinement.
